Centennial Corridor Information Available on Website

Information regarding the proposed Centennial Corridor Project is available online at the City of Bakersfield and Thomas Roads Improvement Program's (TRIP) website: www.BakersfieldFreeways.us.

The purpose of the Centennial Corridor project is to connect SR-58 to I-5, via the Westside Parkway. (*The Westside Parkway, scheduled to begin construction in 2008/09, will ultimately extend west from Truxtun Avenue to Stockdale Highway.*) Centennial Corridor is an integral component in the overall goal of improving east west connectivity in the Bakersfield area.

Available information includes the conceptual alignment map, which shows various alternative alignments under consideration; an information sheet on the project; Frequently Asked Questions; and the exhibits displayed at Caltrans' Public Information Meeting held March 4, 2008.
