Coffee Road Lane Closures

Temporary lane closures on Coffee Road at the Brimhall Road intersection are planned for Wednesday, April 28 and Thursday, April 29, 2010 for utility pot-holing required for the on-going sewer line installation. The work will take place between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m., and two lanes will remain open to traffic, northbound and southbound, at all times. Work on the new sewer line is expected to be complete by mid-May.

Motorists should also anticipate upcoming Coffee Road lane closures from Brimhall Road south to the Cross Valley Canal within the next few weeks, when work to remove an oil line from the center of Coffee Road gets underway. Once the oil line is removed, the contractor for the Westside Parkway will construct the center support columns for the Westside Parkway bridge. These activities will require the closure of the inside traffic lane in each direction of Coffee Road. Two lanes will remain open to traffic, northbound and southbound, while construction is underway. These lane closures are expected to last two to three months.

Motorists should avoid the area when possible or allow additional time when traveling through the area. The Thomas Roads Improvement Program apologizes for any inconvenience this work causes the traveling public.
