Increased construction activity Westside Parkway/Coffee Road bridge abutment site

Security Paving Company plans to place concrete for the new Westside Parkway/Coffee Road bridge abutment on Tuesday, May 25, 2010. Work is not expected to significantly impact traffic, but motorists should remain alert to vehicles that may be entering or leaving the construction site.

The concrete placement will require about 700 cubic yards or about 80 truckloads of concrete. Work is projected to get underway by 7 a.m. and is expected to continue through most of the day. The construction site is located on the west side of Coffee Road, just south of the Brimhall Road intersection.

Motorists may want to avoid the area or allow additional time if traveling through the area. The Thomas Roads Improvement Program apologizes for any inconvenience this work causes the traveling public.
