Shell Oil Company has a project to relocate an existing oil pipeline along Coffee Road between Truxtun Avenue and Brimhall Road, due to the construction of the Westside Parkway. The existing oil pipeline needs to be relocated to make room for the future freeway interchange at Coffee Road and Brimhall Road.

In order to complete this project and tie-in a newly installed pipeline, lane closures on Coffee Road will need to be installed. On July 7, 2010, two of the three northbound lanes on Coffee Road will be closed to vehicle traffic between Truxtun Avenue and Brimhall Road. The travel lanes will be closed from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM on that day. Traffic in this area will be reduced to only one lane in the northbound direction for the entire day. These lane closures are necessary to make the final tie-in to the new pipeline and to completely abandon the old pipeline.
