Lane Closures at Coffee Road/Brimhall Road Intersection Road Work Begins on Allen Road

Lane closures at the Coffee Road and Brimhall Road intersection are planned for Wednesday through Friday, July 21-23, 2010, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. The closures include the northbound outside turn lane on Coffee Road and the outside westbound lane on Brimhall Road. One left turn lane on Coffee Road and one westbound lane on Brimhall Road will be open to motorists while work is underway. The lane closures are necessary to work on a new sewer line in conjunction with construction of the Westside Parkway.

City crews will also begin working on a widening project at Allen Road this week, beginning Tuesday, July 20. Crews will widen the current two-lane section, between San Juan Avenue to just south of Brimhall Road, to four lanes. This widening project is in preparation of the closure of Jewetta Avenue, between Braemar Lane and Pecos River Drive, for construction of a new bridge that will cross over the Westside Parkway.

Motorists may want to take an alternate route or allow additional time if traveling through these areas. The Thomas Roads Improvement Program apologizes for any inconvenience this work causes the traveling public.
