Traffic Advisory

7th Standard Road at Santa Fe Way

Motorists are advised to expect long, intermittent traffic delays on 7th Standard Road and Santa Fe Way, near the new grade separation construction, on September 15-16, 2010. Traffic may be stopped, for up to 20 minutes at a time, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4 p.m.

The traffic interruptions are needed to allow Granite Construction, the contractor for the new grade separation, to safely place the large, pre-cast girders required for the bridge construction. The contractor will place 10 girders over the two-day period, coordinating work within openings in the daily train schedules.

Motorists are advised to avoid the area and use an alternate route, if possible. If traveling through the area is unavoidable, please allow for adequate travel time.

The Kern County Roads Department and the Thomas Roads Improvement Program apologizes for any inconvenience this work causes the traveling public.
